ENVIRONMENT CONDITIONS

The temperature of the surface should be at least 3° C higher than the DewPoint of the air. Temperature and relative humidity should be measured in the vicinity of the substrate. The maximum recommended surface temperature is 40° C. In extreme cases, it may be necessary to reduce film thickness in order to avoid sagging. When applying the paint in confined spaces, provide adequate ventilation during application and drying. The temperature of the mixed paint should be at least 10° C. Otherwise extra solvent may be needed to obtain a proper application viscosity. Relative humidity must not be over %90. Should only be applied on completely dry surfaces where the ambient temperature is at least -7° C.
